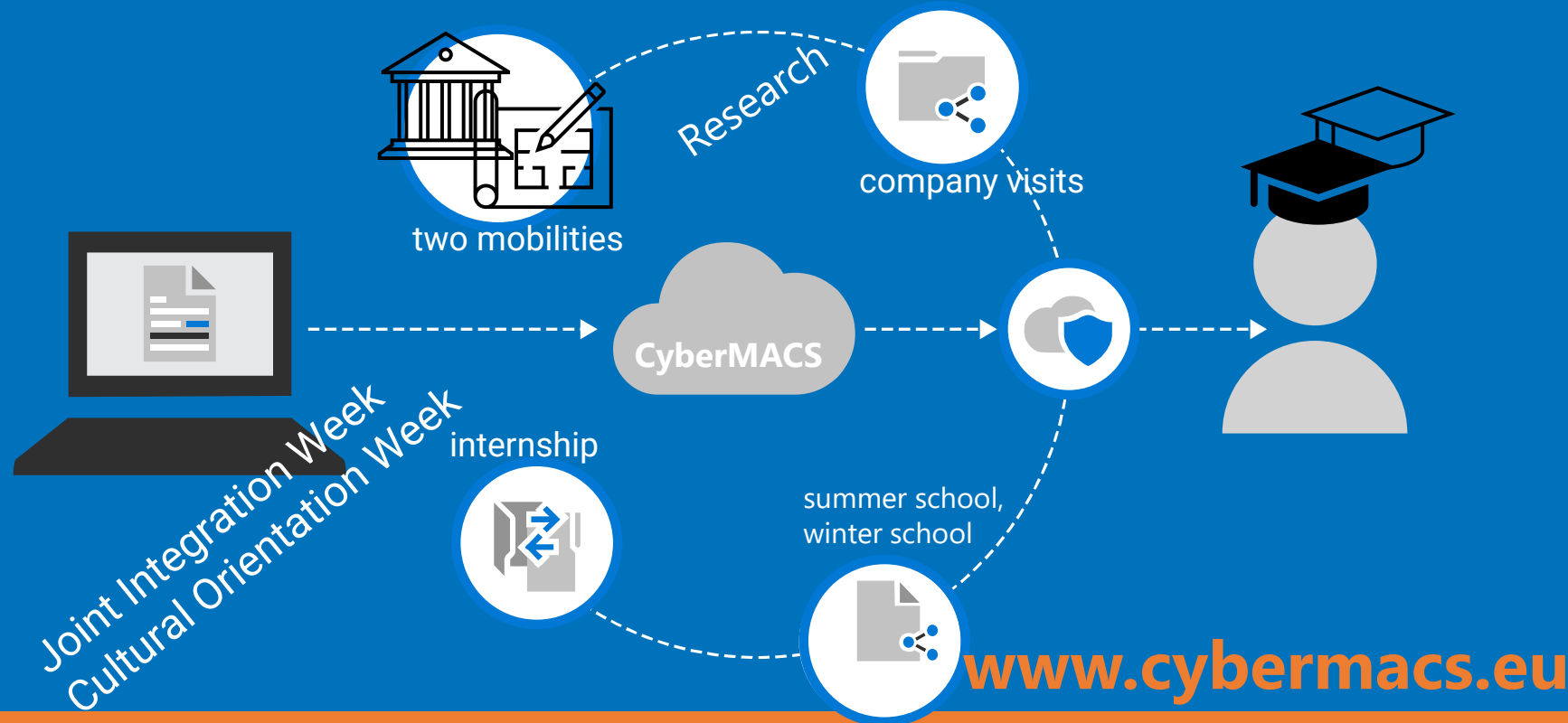

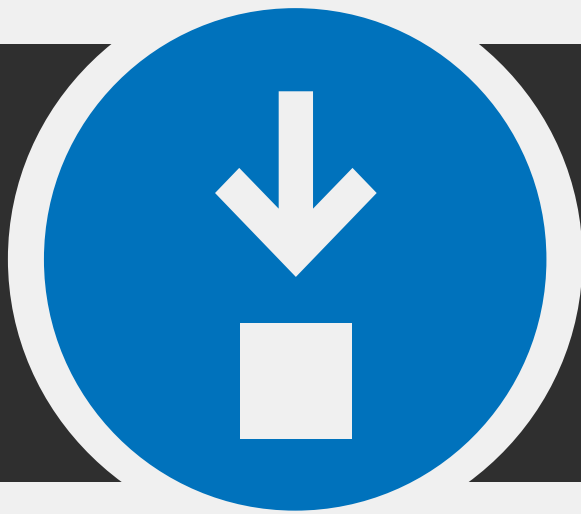

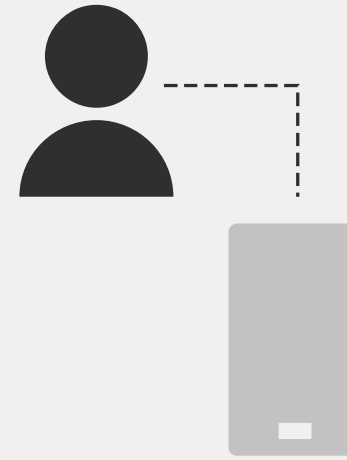

The number of students in first intake 2023/2024



- 731 applicants were assessed and 334 applicants were qualified
- 137 applicants from 35 nationalities were elevated to the detailed academic merit-based processing and ranking level

74 applicants from 32 nationalities out of 137 applicants were interviewed



The number of students in second intake 2024/2025

- 926 applicants were assessed and 761 applicants were qualified
- 372 applicants from **54** nationalities were elevated to the detailed academic merit-based processing and ranking level

129 applicants from 52 nationalities out of 372 applicants were interviewed (appr. 35%)



Participants on Joint Integration Week and Cultural Orientation Week 2024/2025

JIW

- **92.6%** of participants attending all days. The welcome on the first day was rated as "Excellent" **by 74%** of the participants, setting a positive tone for the rest of the event.

COW

- The survey revealed that **85%** of the respondents attended at least 80% of the program. **21** Different Nationality participated.

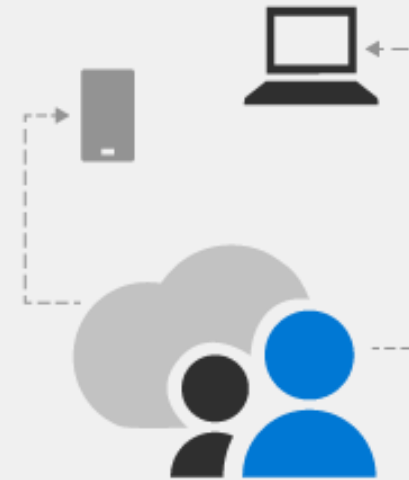
Networking Success

Most participants (93%) reported valuable networking opportunities with peers and industry professionals, which they found beneficial for learning and future career prospects.

The number of participants on Summer School 2024



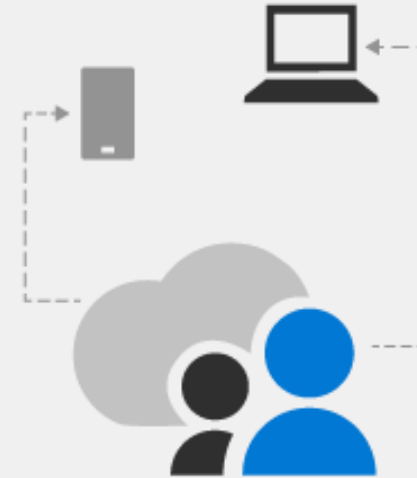
80 % of attendees valued the networking opportunities with guest lecturers

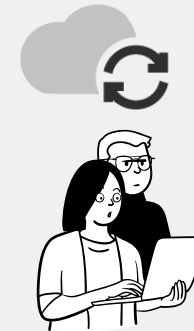

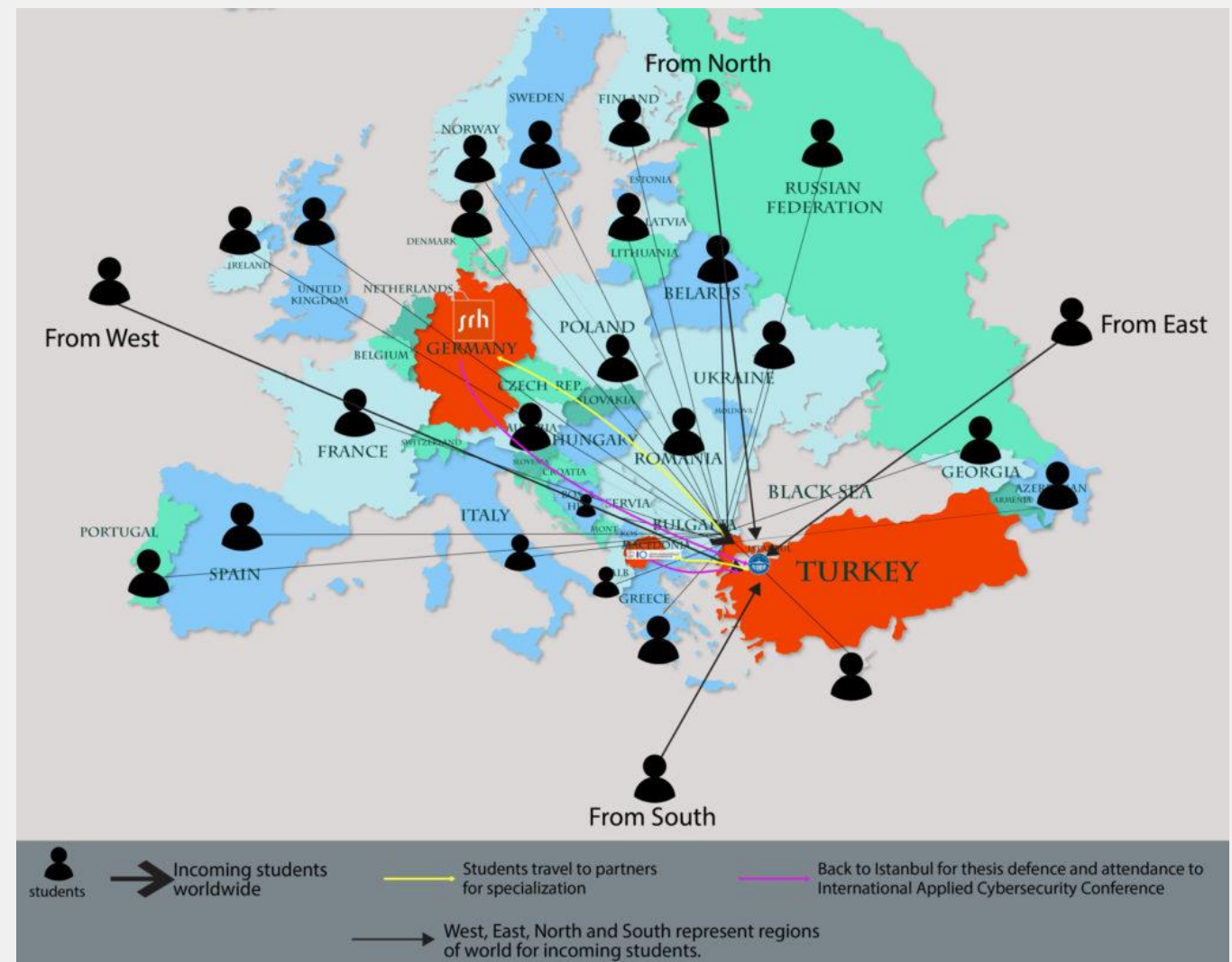
